Includes priority lake access, use of boats and canoes, use of the Wayne Bank Teaching/Wet Laboratory

GENERAL SITE USAGE + DR. SUSAN S. KILHAM ANALYTICAL LABORATORY:

Includes site use as described above and access to analytical laboratory equipment including purified water (MilliQ), balances (laboratory, analytical, and micro), scanning spectrophotometer, multi-mode plate reader, fluorometer, drying oven, vacuum filtration, acid bath, heat block, and glass and plastic ware.

Exclusive use of the historic Icehouse which sleeps 3-6 people, 1 bathroom, kitchenette (stocked with flatware, dishware, cookware, fridge, freezer, and dry storage), and living space. Includes wifi. First night's fee includes a cleaning charge.
